Four-Suit Transfers - Bridgebum Four-suit transfers are a method of transferring into any suit after partner opens 1NT. 2D, 2H, 2S and 2NT are all transfer bids. Four Suit Transfer Bids - Bridge Guys This first response transfers the No Trump bidder to Clubs. 3 : Transfer accepted and bid. 3 : The responder, wishing to show game values, bids the suit, in which he holds a singleton or void. 4 : The No Trump bidder realizes that a strong inference must be made that there is no stopper in the Heart suit. Four Suit Transfers - Omaha Bridge A fairly common convention these days is that called Four Suit Transfers. The name is indicative of what it allows---- after a 1NT opening bid responder has the ability to transfer to any one of the four suits. This makes it an extended version of Jacoby transfers bids in that responder is also able to transfer to either minor suit.

With 4-suit transfers the hand-type you lose is the minor-suit slam type where responder doesn't have 6 or more cards. You get a few of these back if you use 1NT - 3M for the fragment or shortage with a (31)(45) hand.

4 suit Transfers: Bridge Bidding Convention Minor suit transfers should not be done with a weak suit with only 5 of the minor. Just pass and let partner play 1NT. You need at least a 6 card suit to transfer. Minor suit transfer | Contract Bridge | FANDOM powered by ... Conventions for extending this to minor suits are called minor suit transfers, but there are very different variations. In all cases, for single-suited transfers, at least 6 cards in a minor is needed, and if the hand is not weak, denies a 4-card major.

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
